Geneva Ward was sent to Girl's State by the American Legion Auxilliary. Elizabeth Waters won the Home Economics Award.

At last the eagerly awaited month of April arrived - the month when we would entertain the Seniors at a banquet at the Community Building. For some of the girls it meant buying their first formals. The theme of the Banquet was "A Southern Plantation". After our class president, Bennie Lamm, gave the address of welcome and introduced the special guests, we stuffed ourselves with chicken and all the good things that go with it. After dancing till the clock struck twelve, we hurried home never to forget our wonderful banquet. We will never forget the beach trip made possible by Captain E. B. Littleton at the close of school.

Our class will never forget the night Robert Pate was hurt in the New Bern-Swansboro game and the day we were told that he had died. After that our boys did not seem to like sports so much.

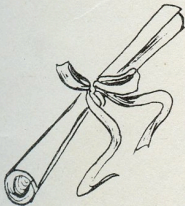
