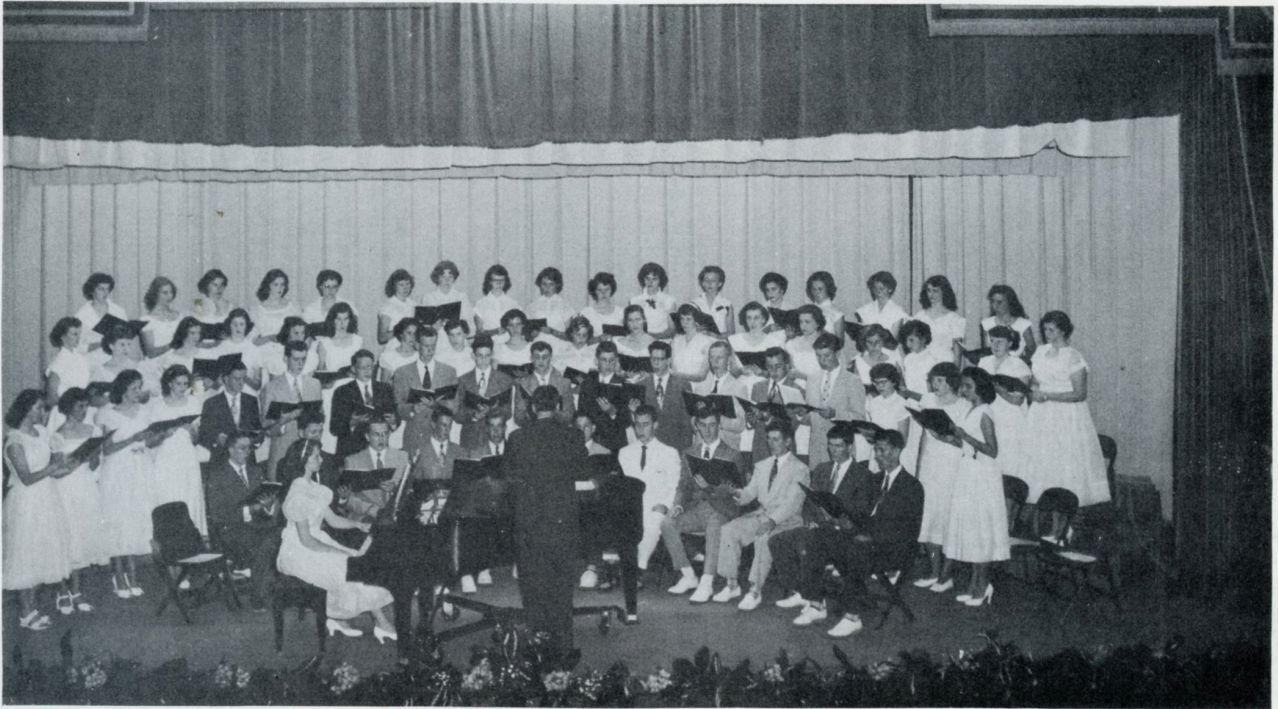
# Band
