

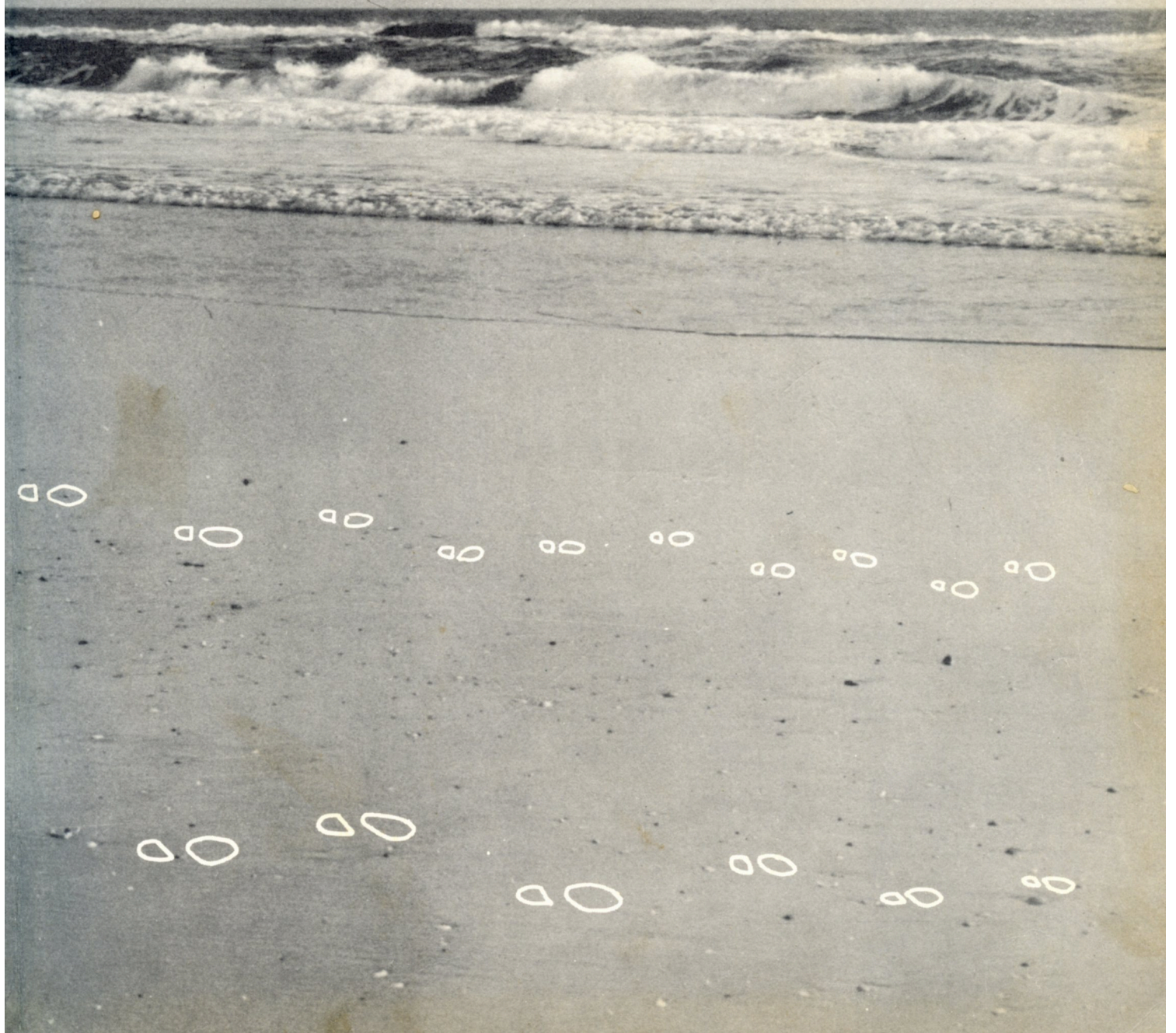

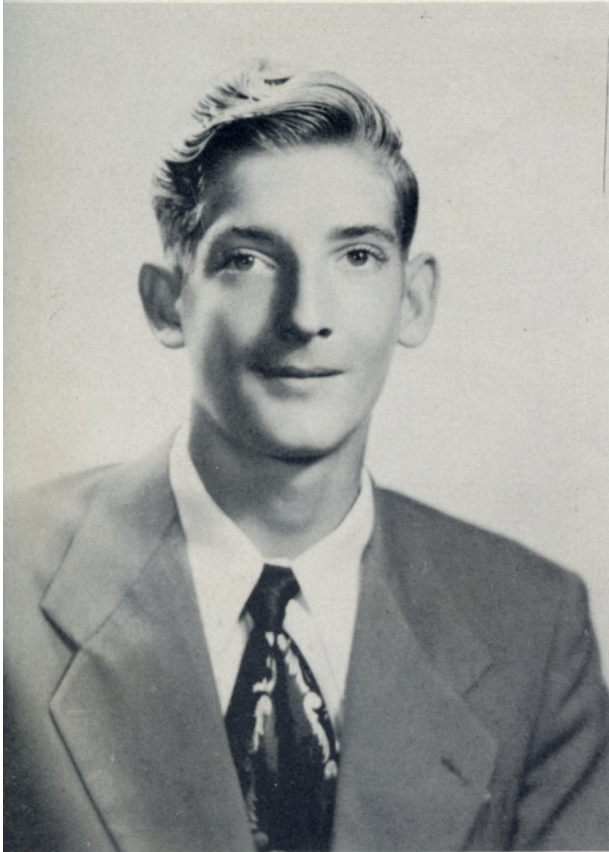

Death far from his mind.

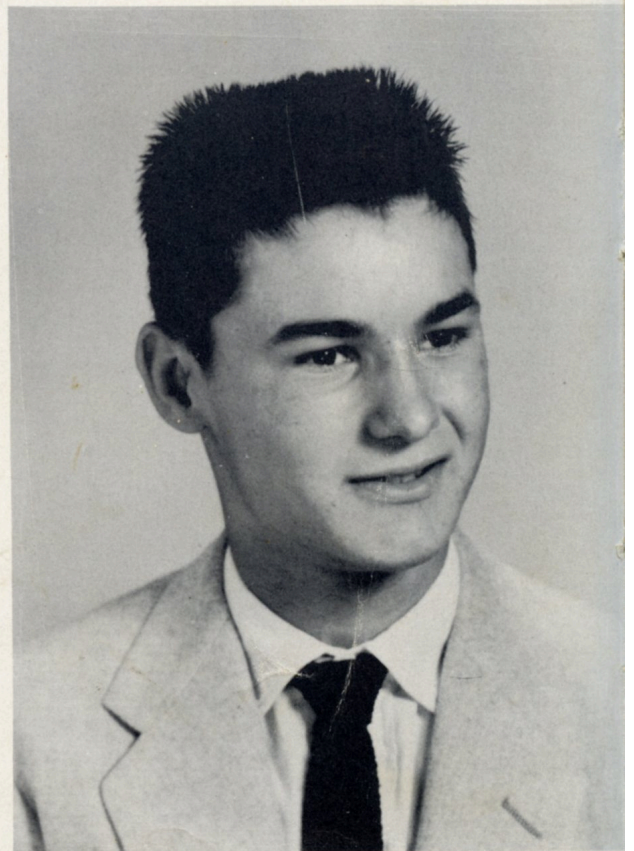
The night was clear and lovely, with bright

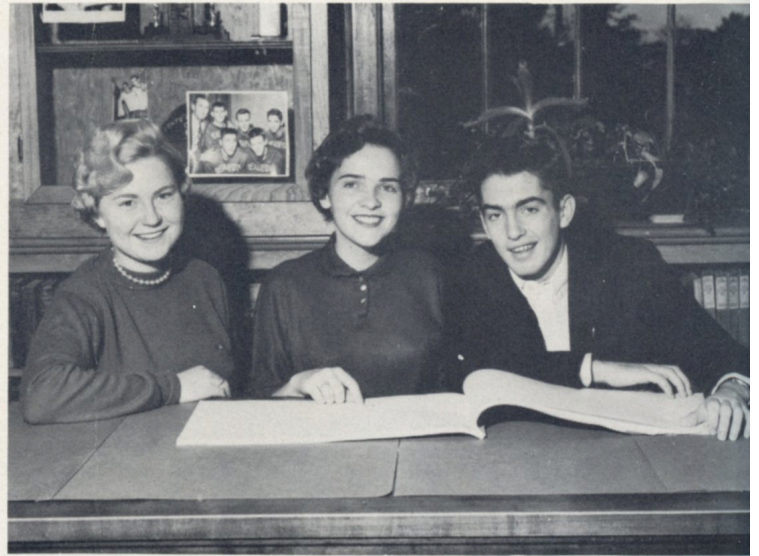
The activities and organizations make up a large portion of our school life. To us they seem most important, for we realize they develop initiative, leadership, traditions, and a sense of responsibility.
