
She has tried every possible way to give us knowledge from her own great store of wisdom, and she has tried unceasingly to instill in us a love of learning and to inspire us to life's greater things.






### *Principal's Message*





Our thanks to our beloved principal and to our faculty for helping us the graduating class of '58 to become one of the greatest in the Annals of B. H. S.




