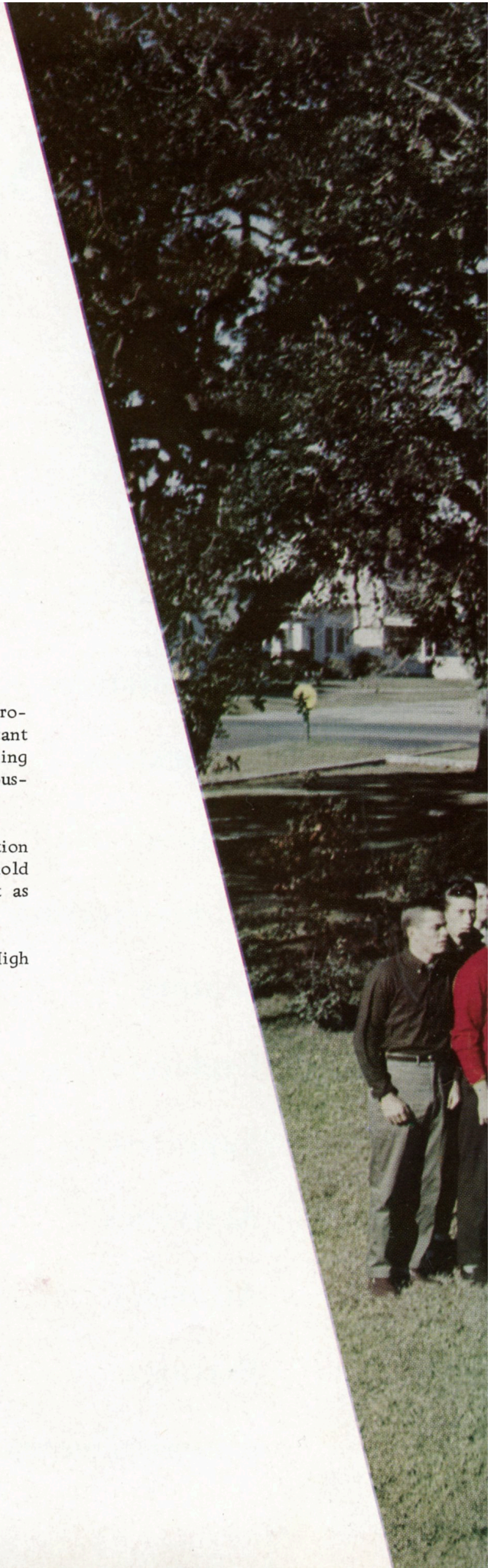


Presentation
