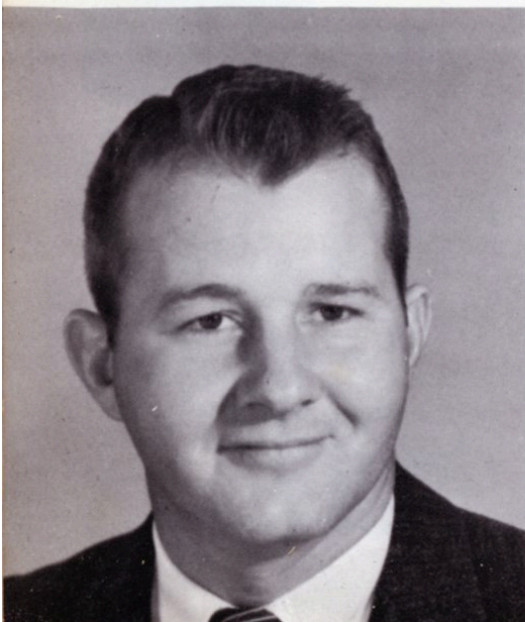
Class History

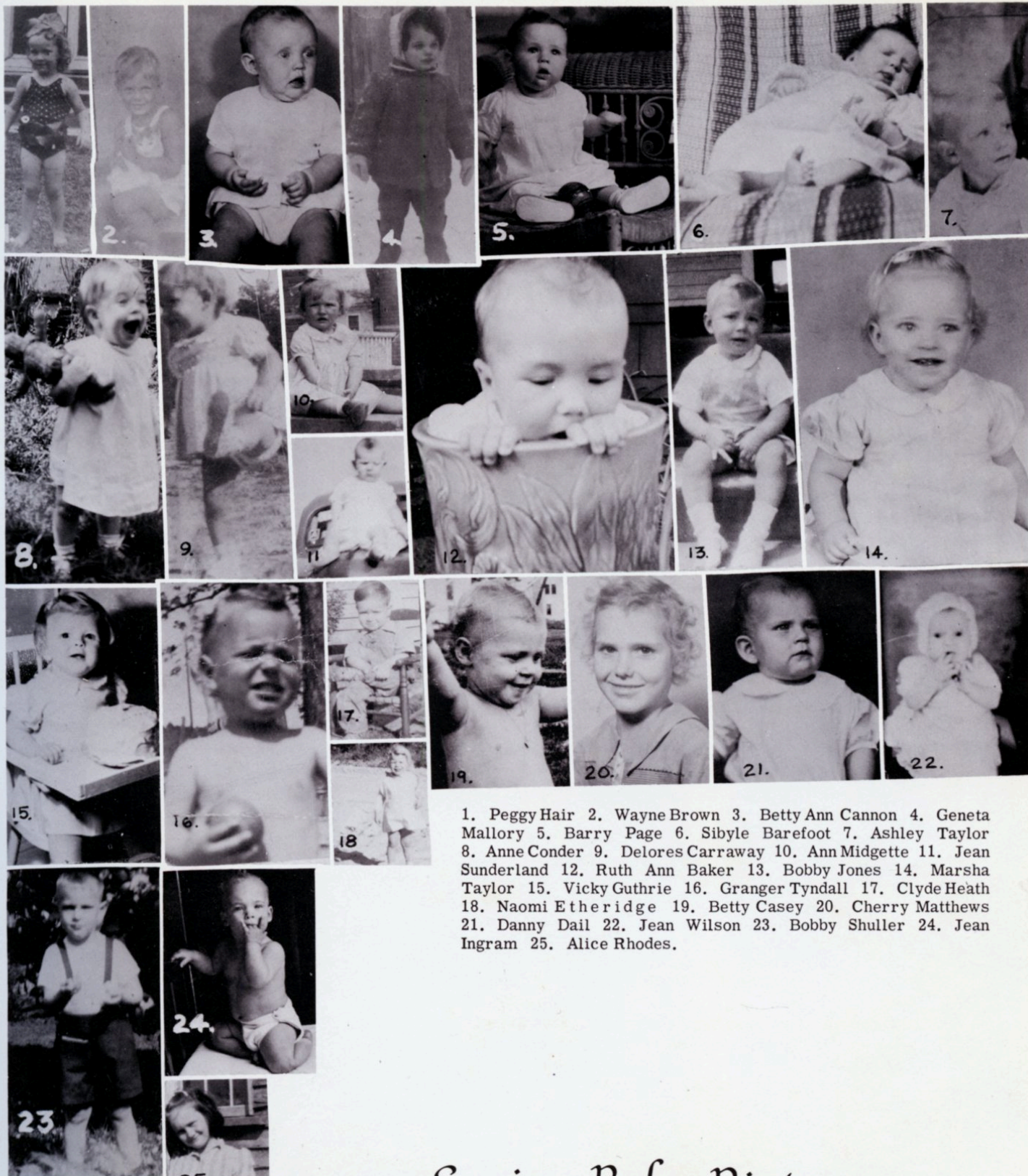
We do hereby make, publish, and declare the following to be our last will and testament:
