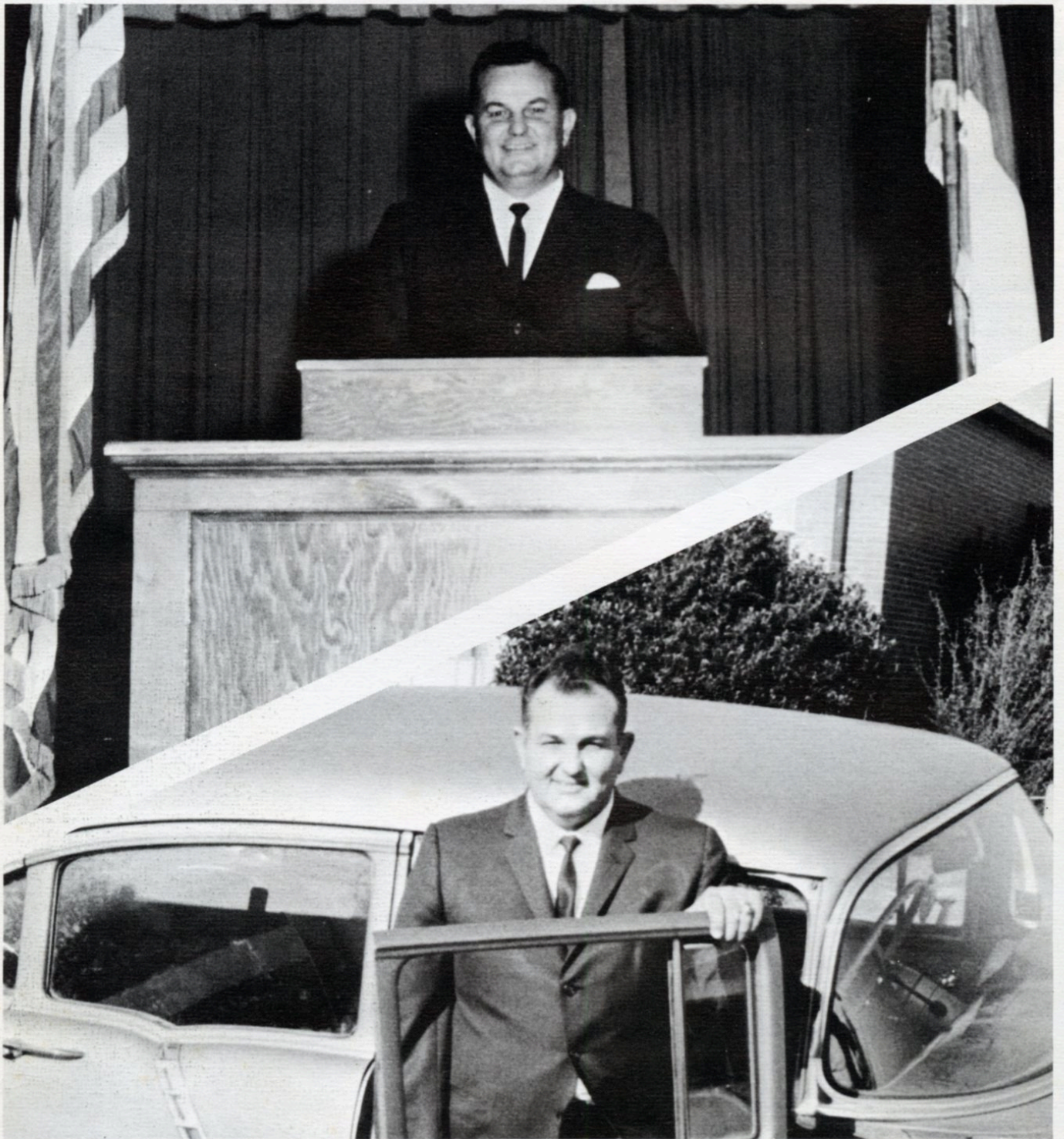








# Principal: Mr. W.J. Taylor
