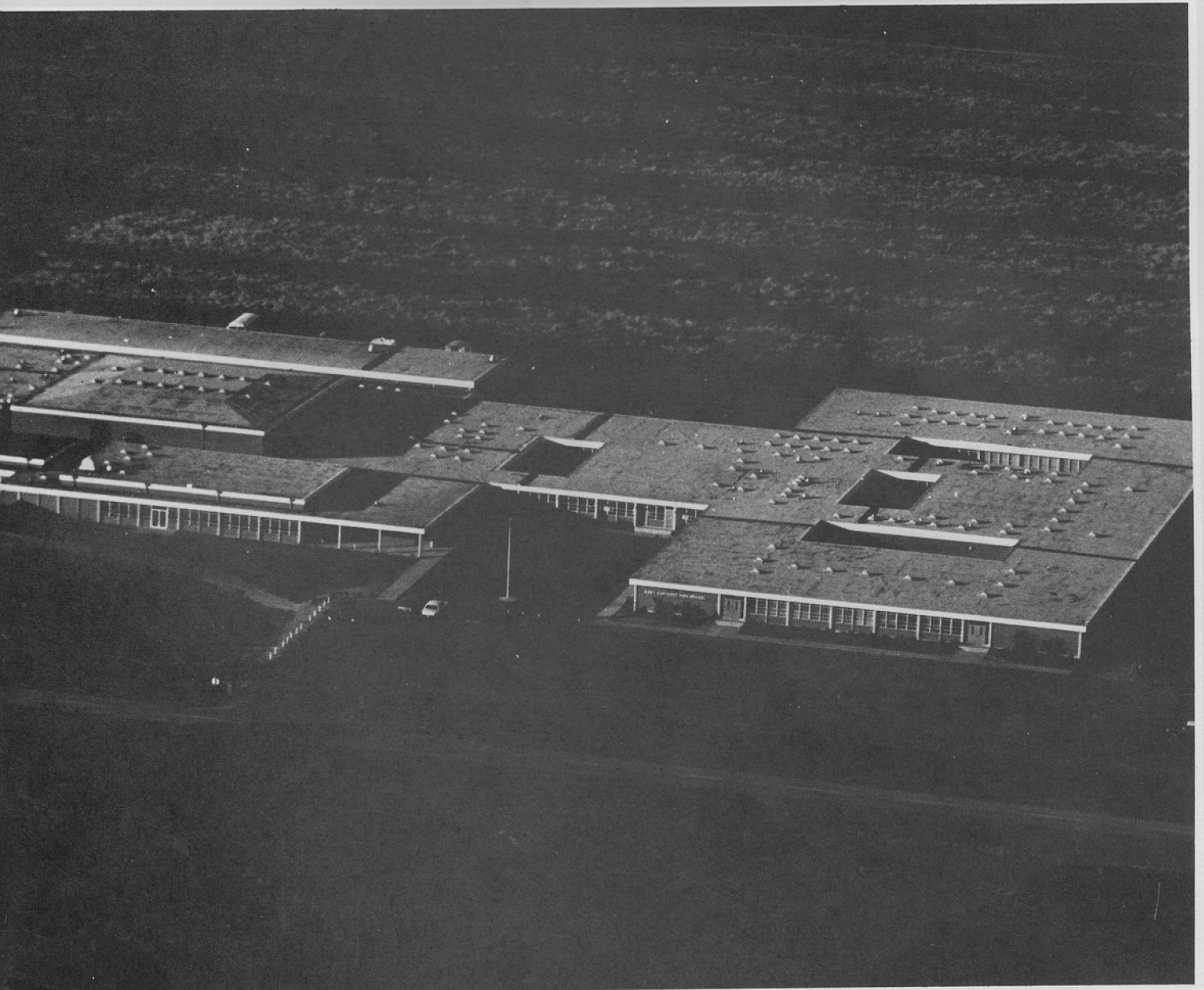

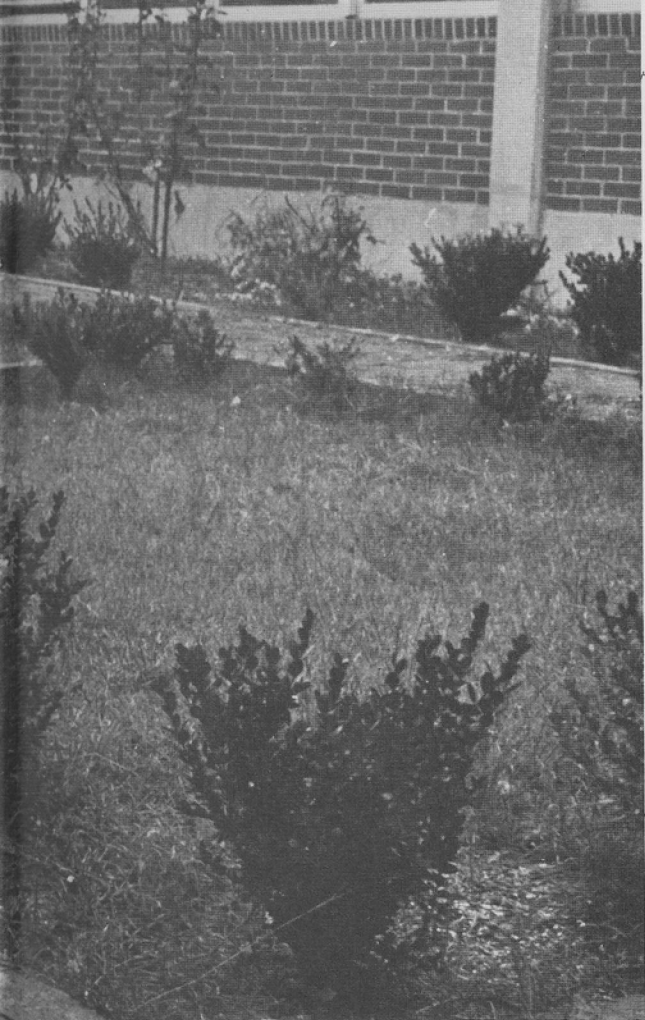

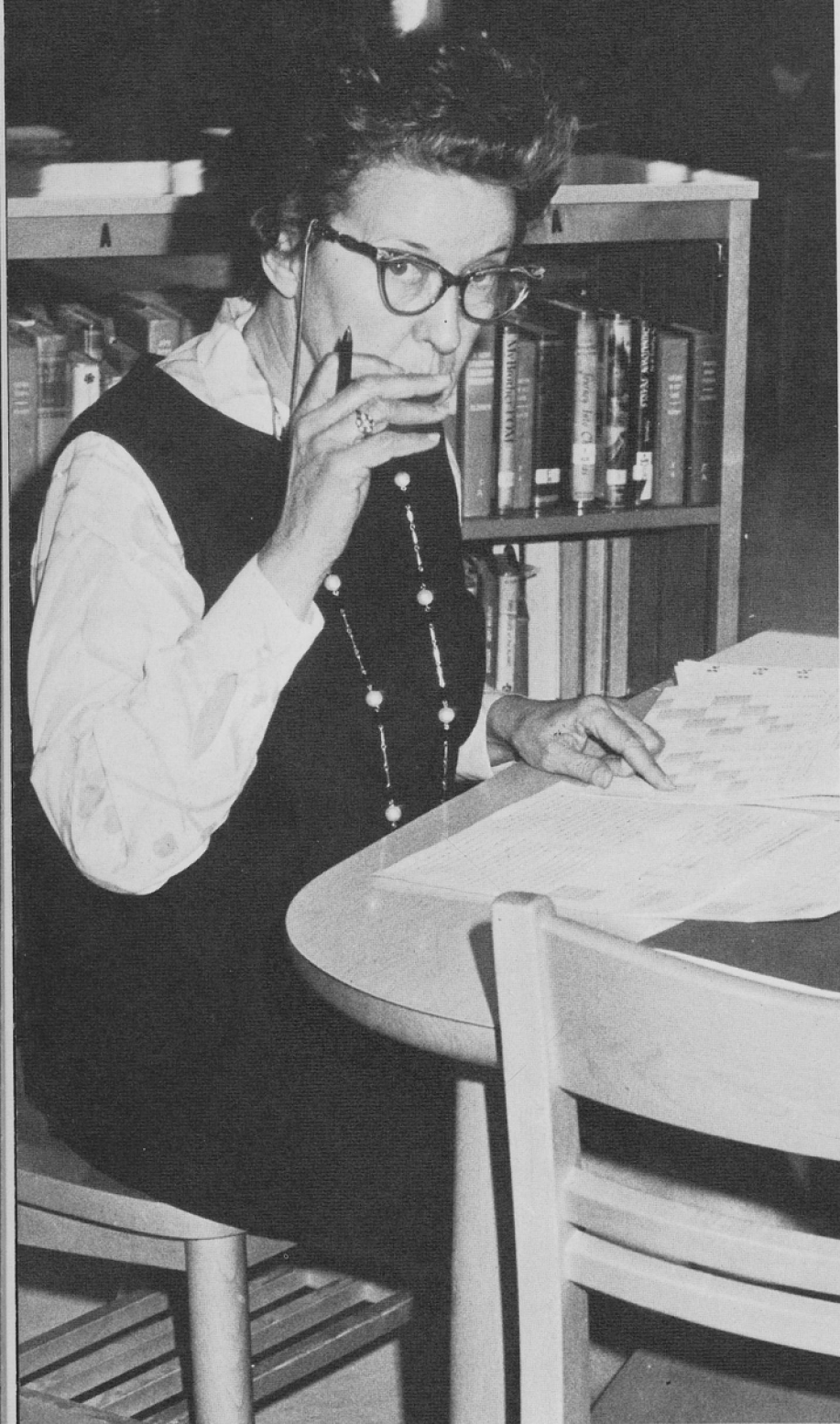

The yearbook staff salutes and proudly dedicates the 1970 East Wind to Mrs. Jessie Parker.



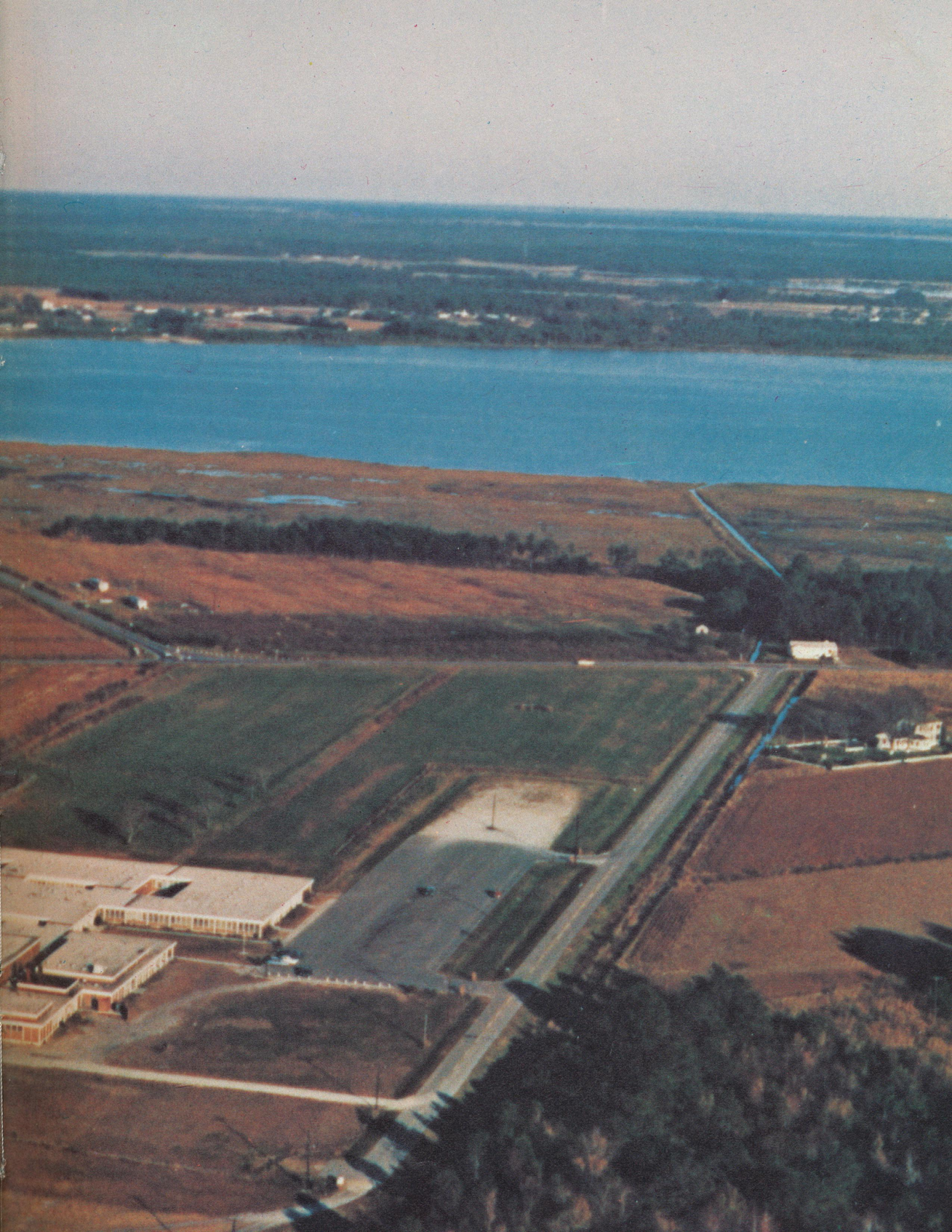

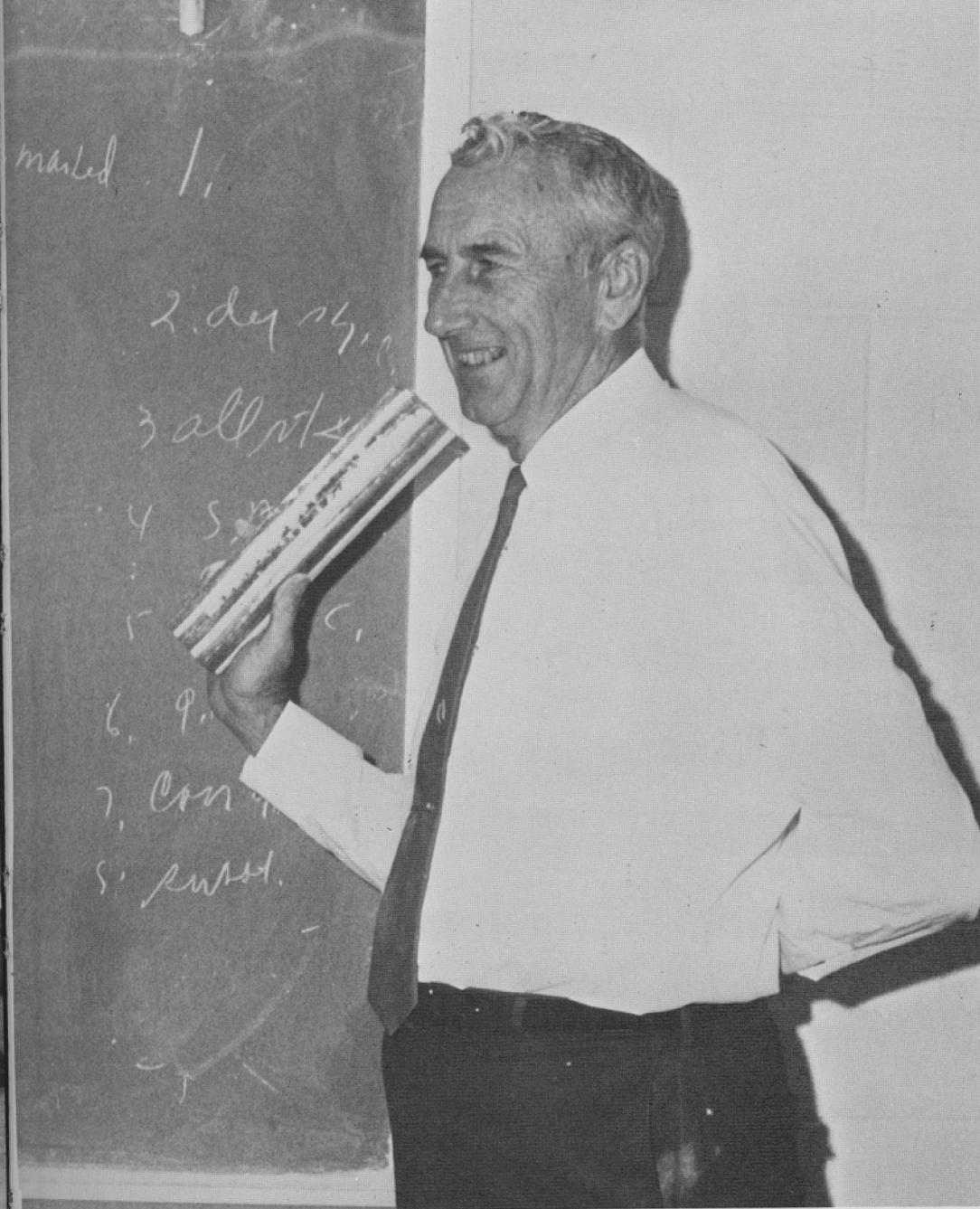


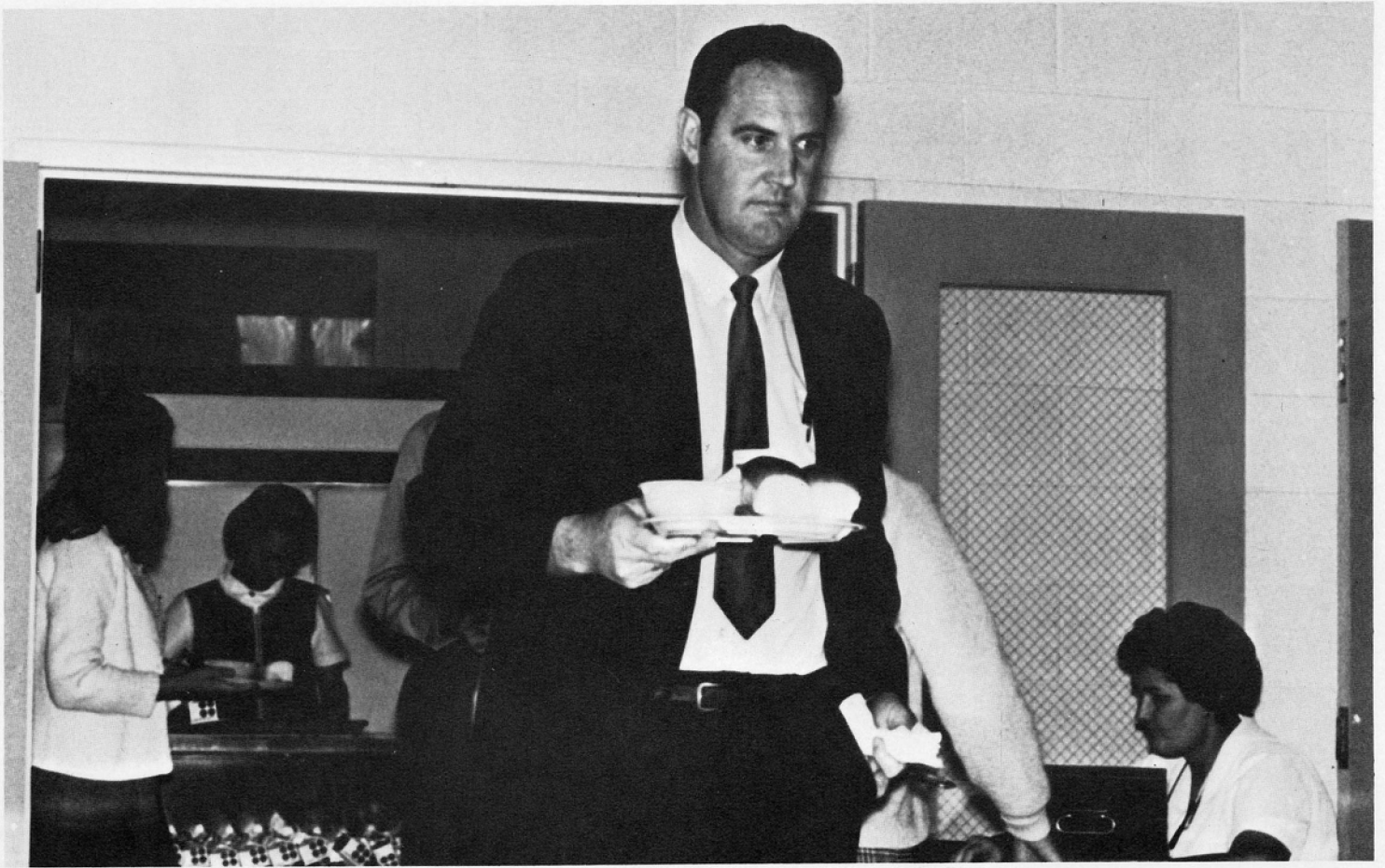


Faculty

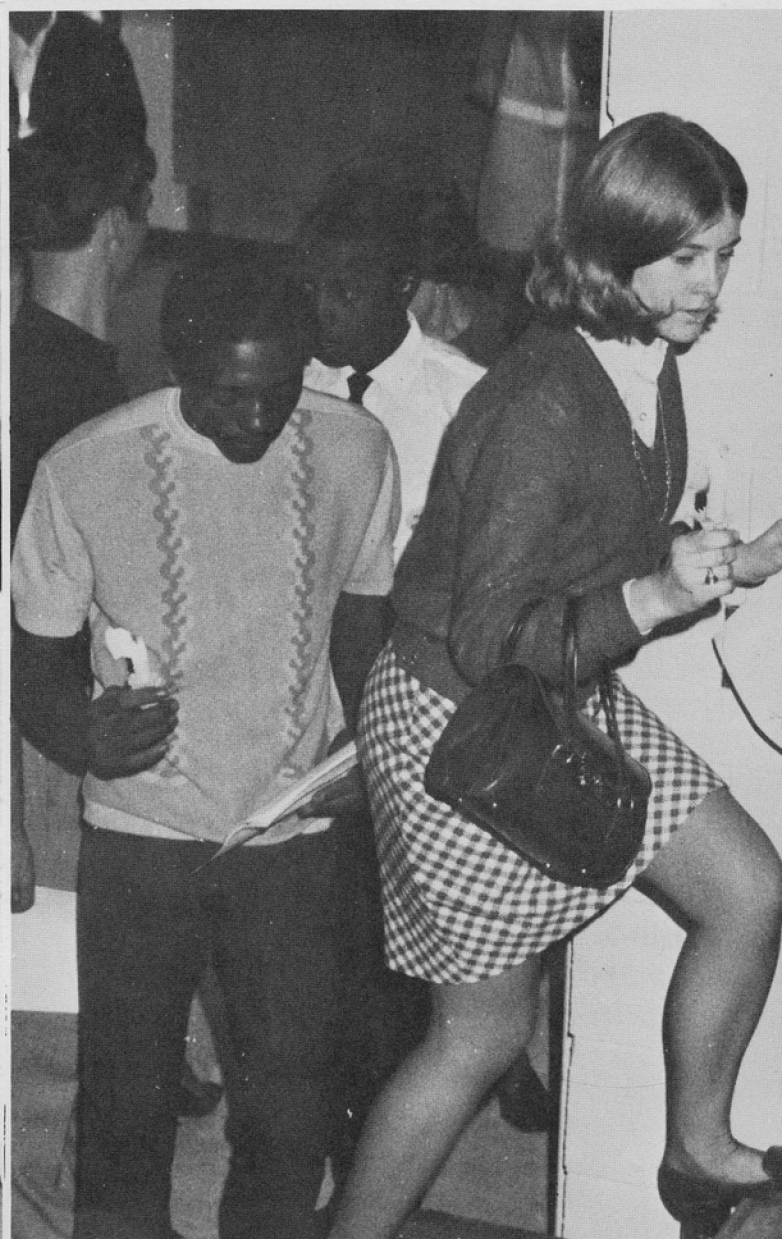


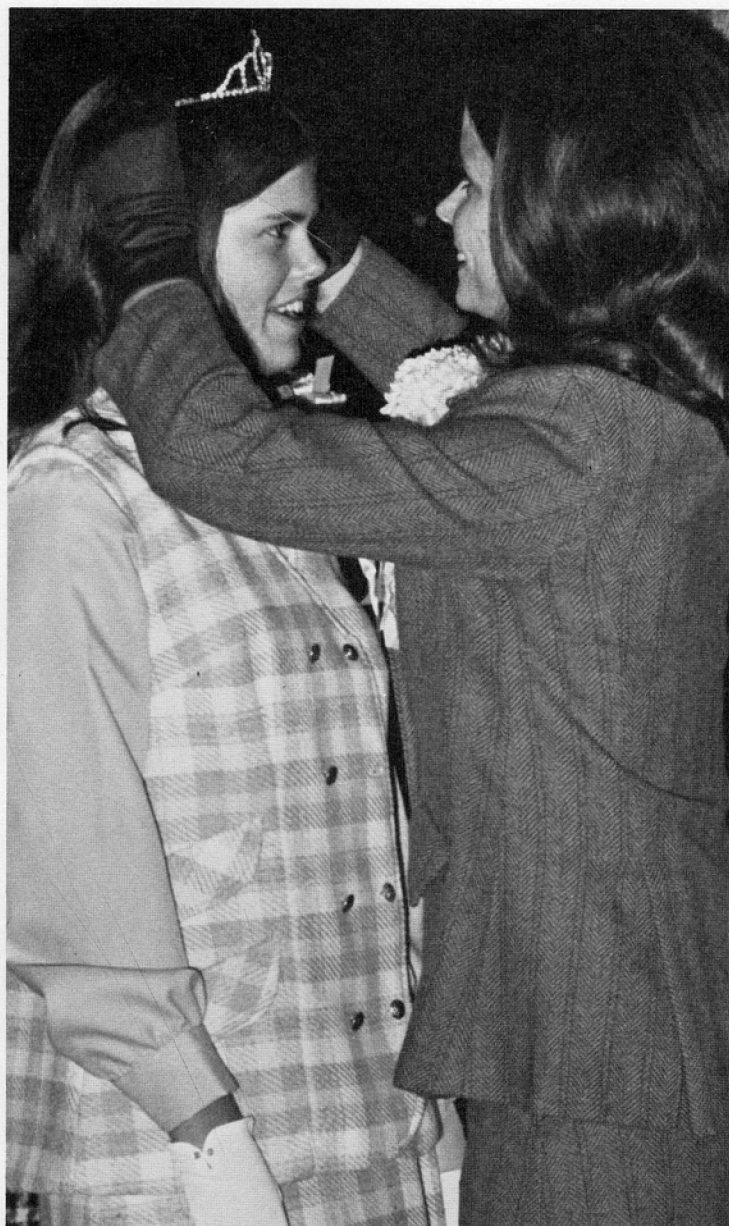


Features

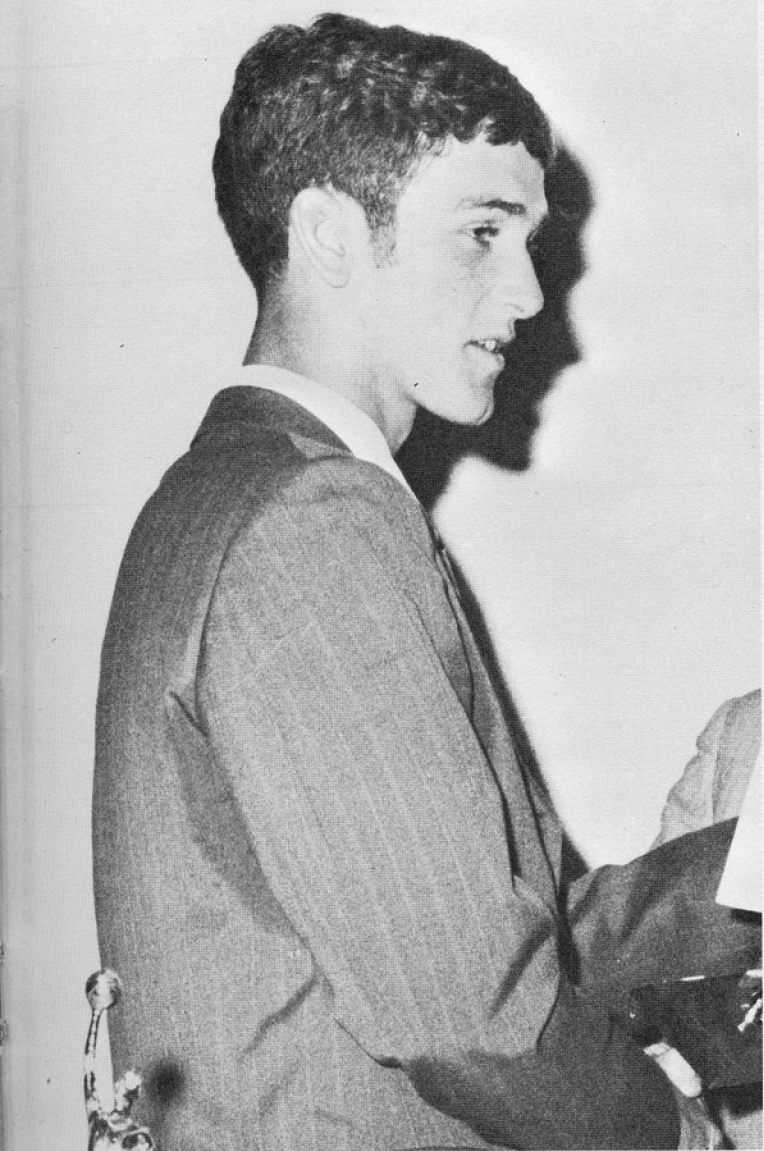
The Most Improved Open Court Award went to the Juniors and the Most Outstanding Award went to the Seniors.

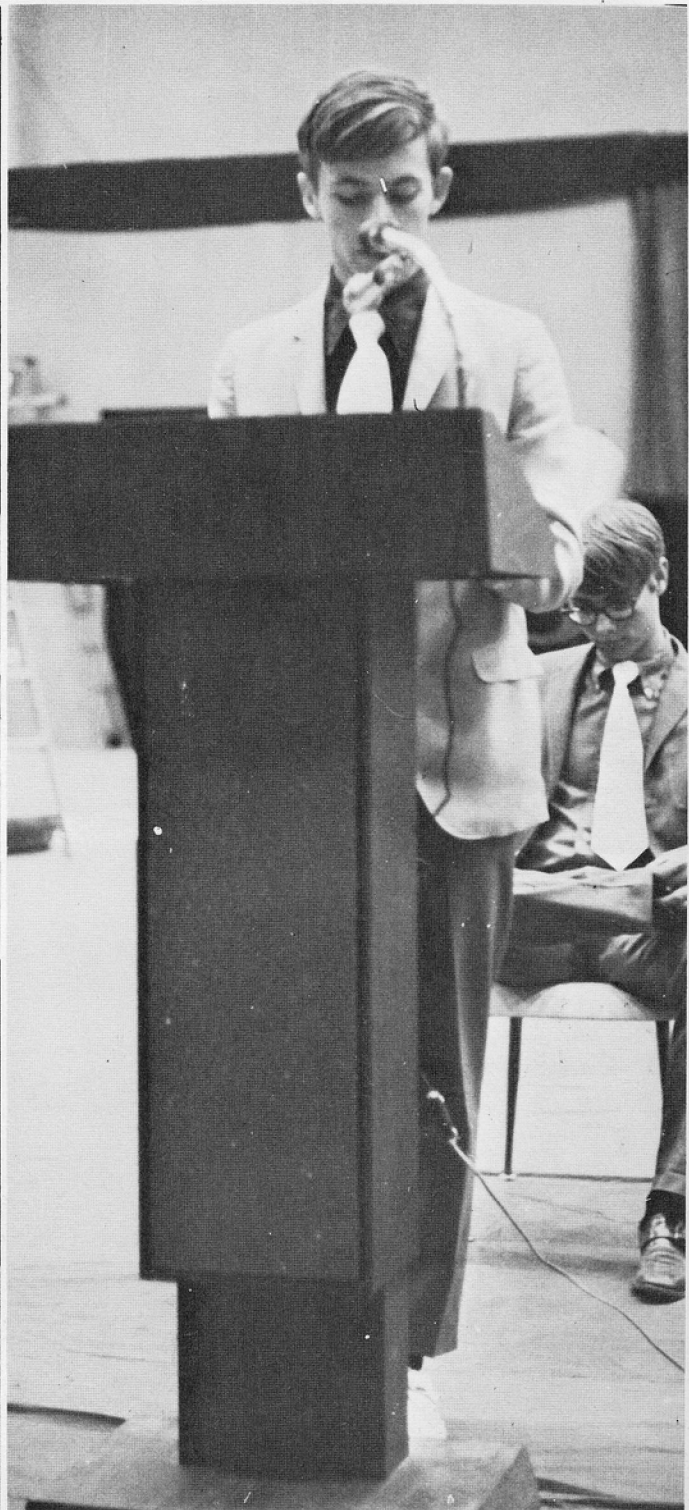

The players on the whole exhibited fine sportsmanship and in all ball games fought with courage and a never-say-die spirit.

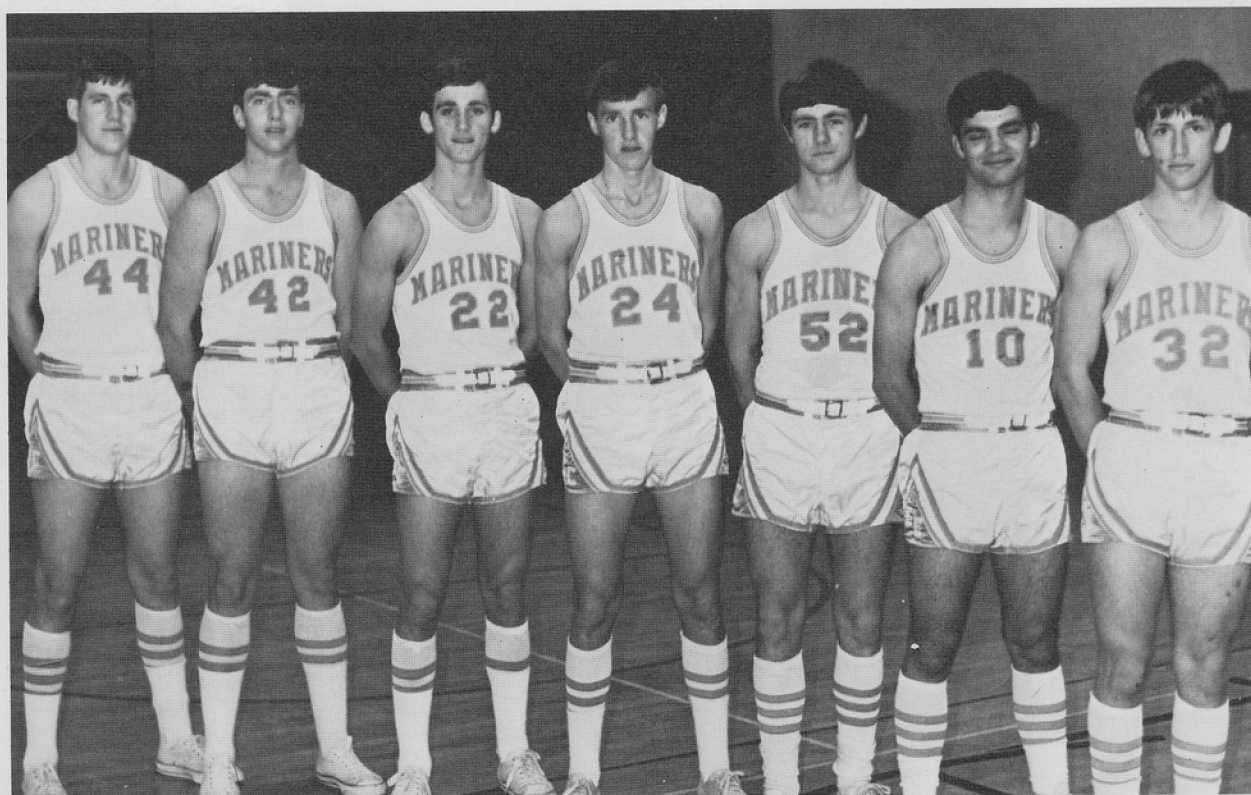

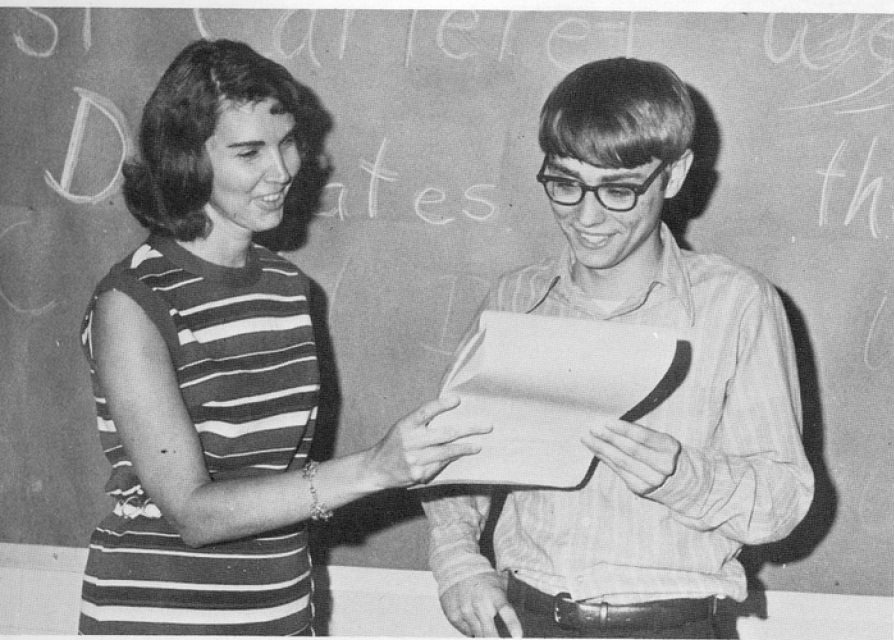


Organizations

The main objective of the Student Council is seeing that the Student Body has a voice in school affairs. This is carried out by a representative form of government.

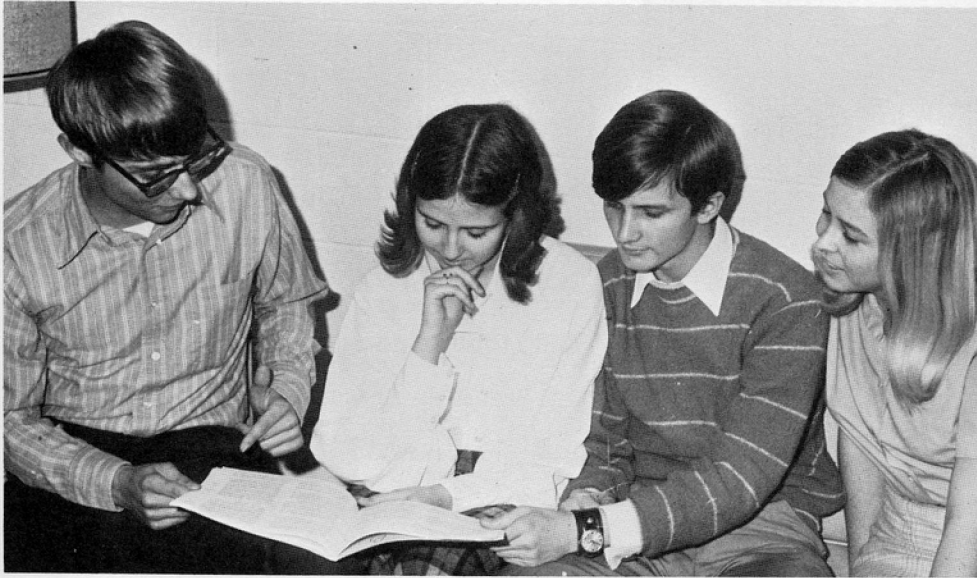
