





# **Faculty**


# Charlotte Nelson Crowned "1970 May Queen"



After the Baccalaureate service, a reception was held for the seniors and their parents.


















# Athletics . .















# **Organizations**

The main objective of the Student Council is seeing that the Student Body has a voice in school affairs. This is carried out by a representative form of government.


