

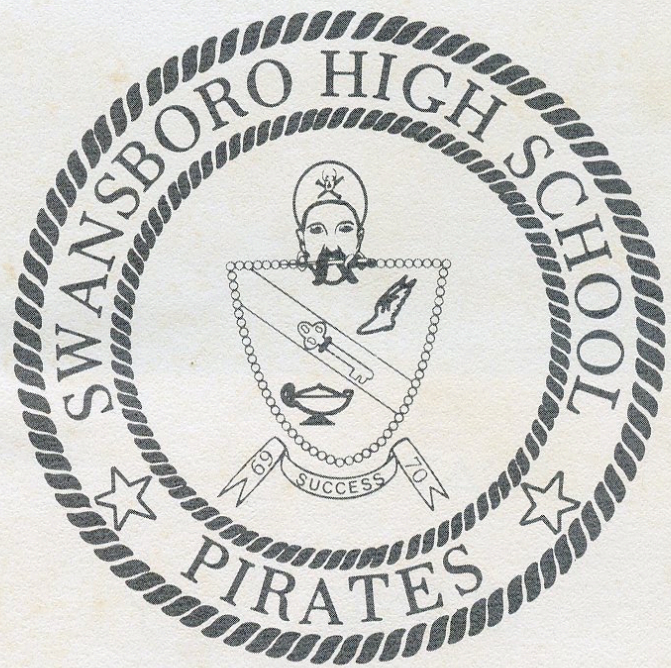

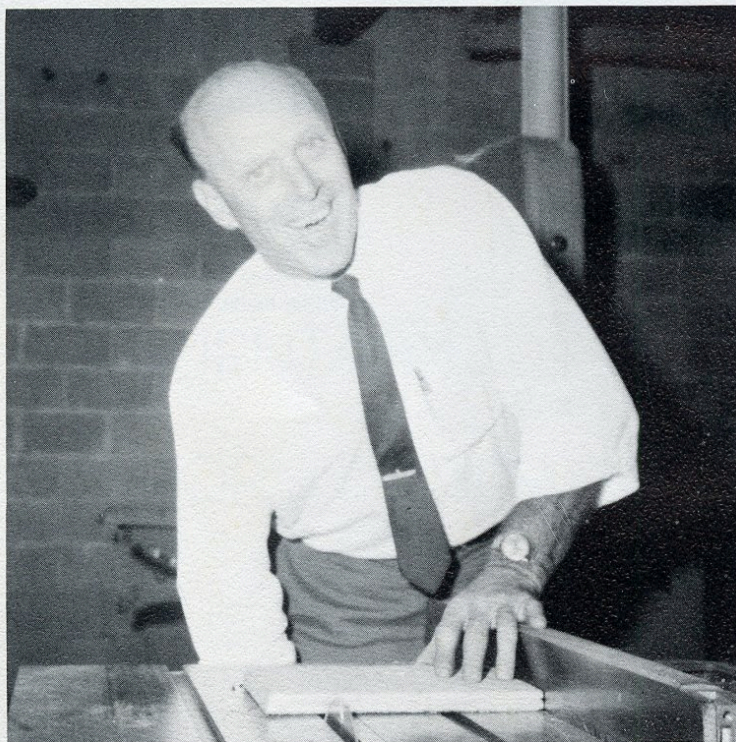

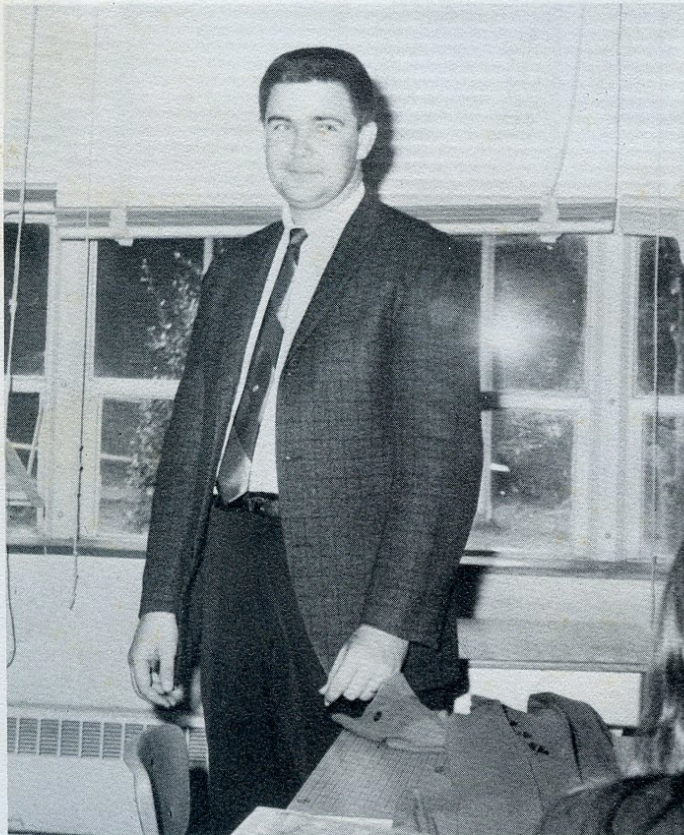


# ACADEMICS

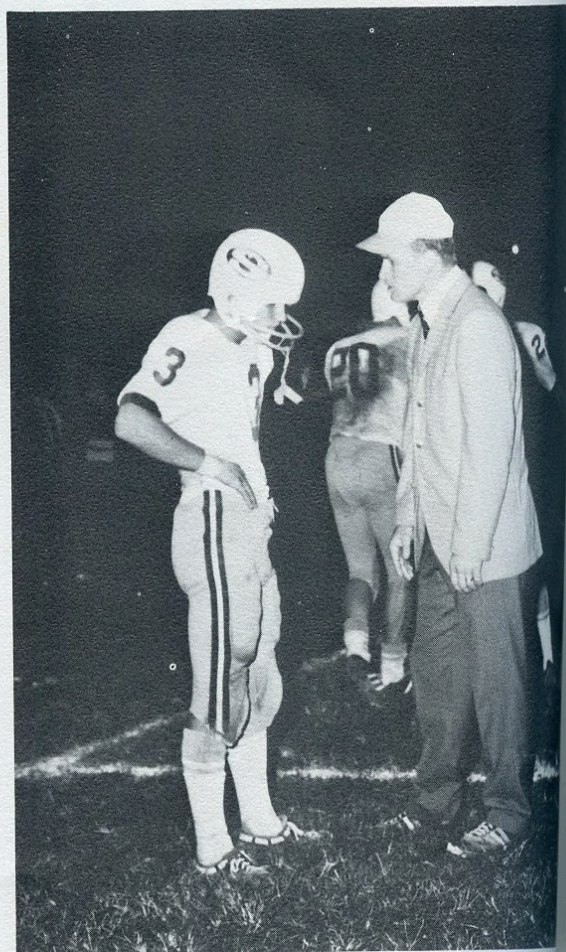
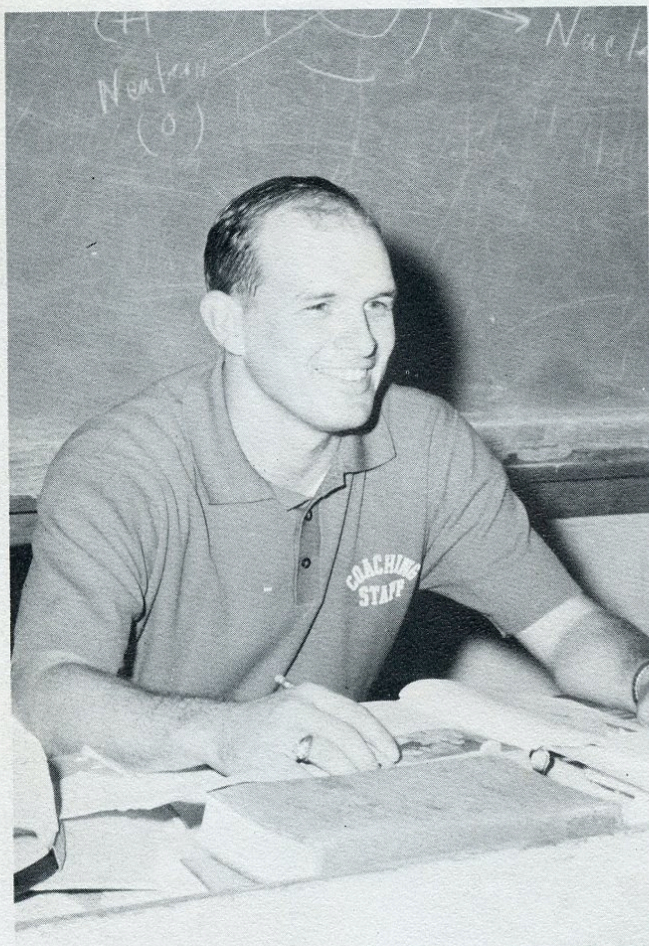
# Coach Bowles

# Coach Ross

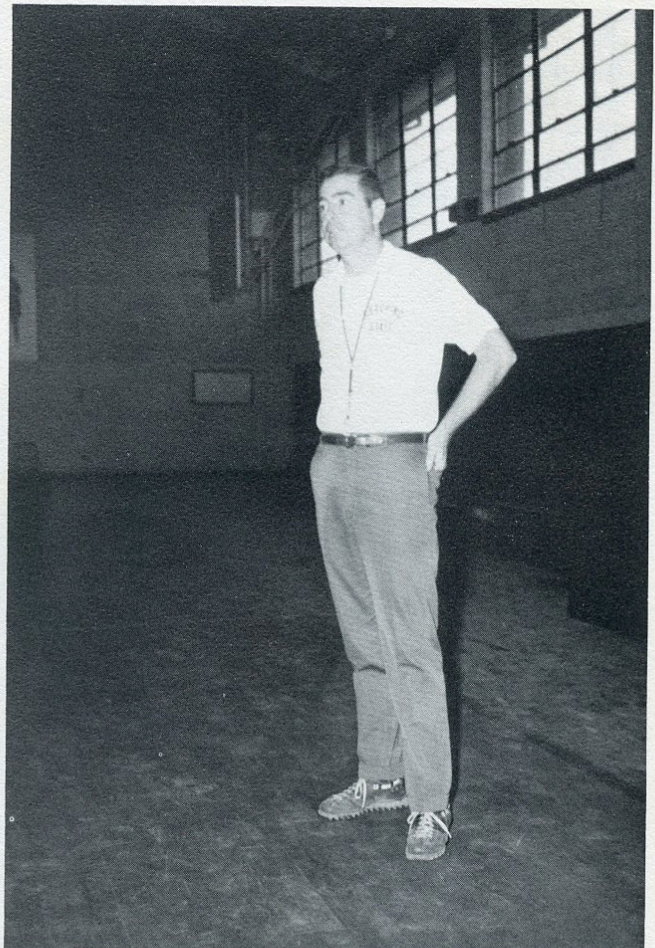
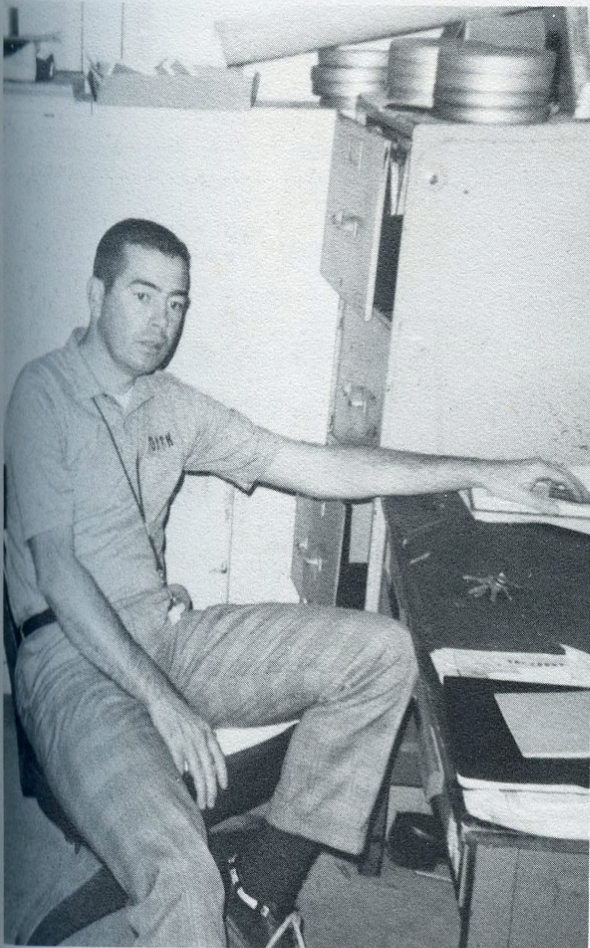


Swansboro is proud to have such a capable coach and wonderful person as Mr. Ronnie Ross in its administration.

Coach Ronnie Ross is a credit to his profession and a well loved personality. We at SHS are happy to have you aboard!

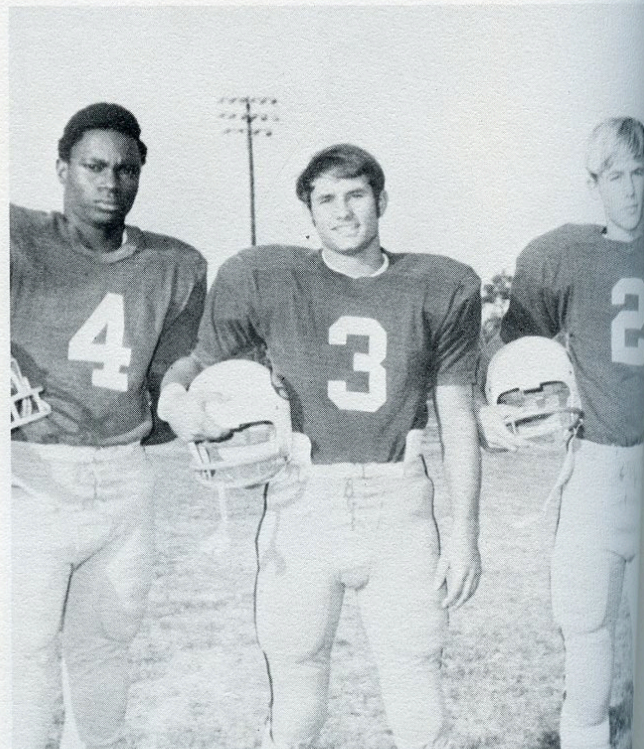

This year has been fantastic. I, along with the staff, hope the 1970 Pirate has captured the important moments as a lasting record in our memories.



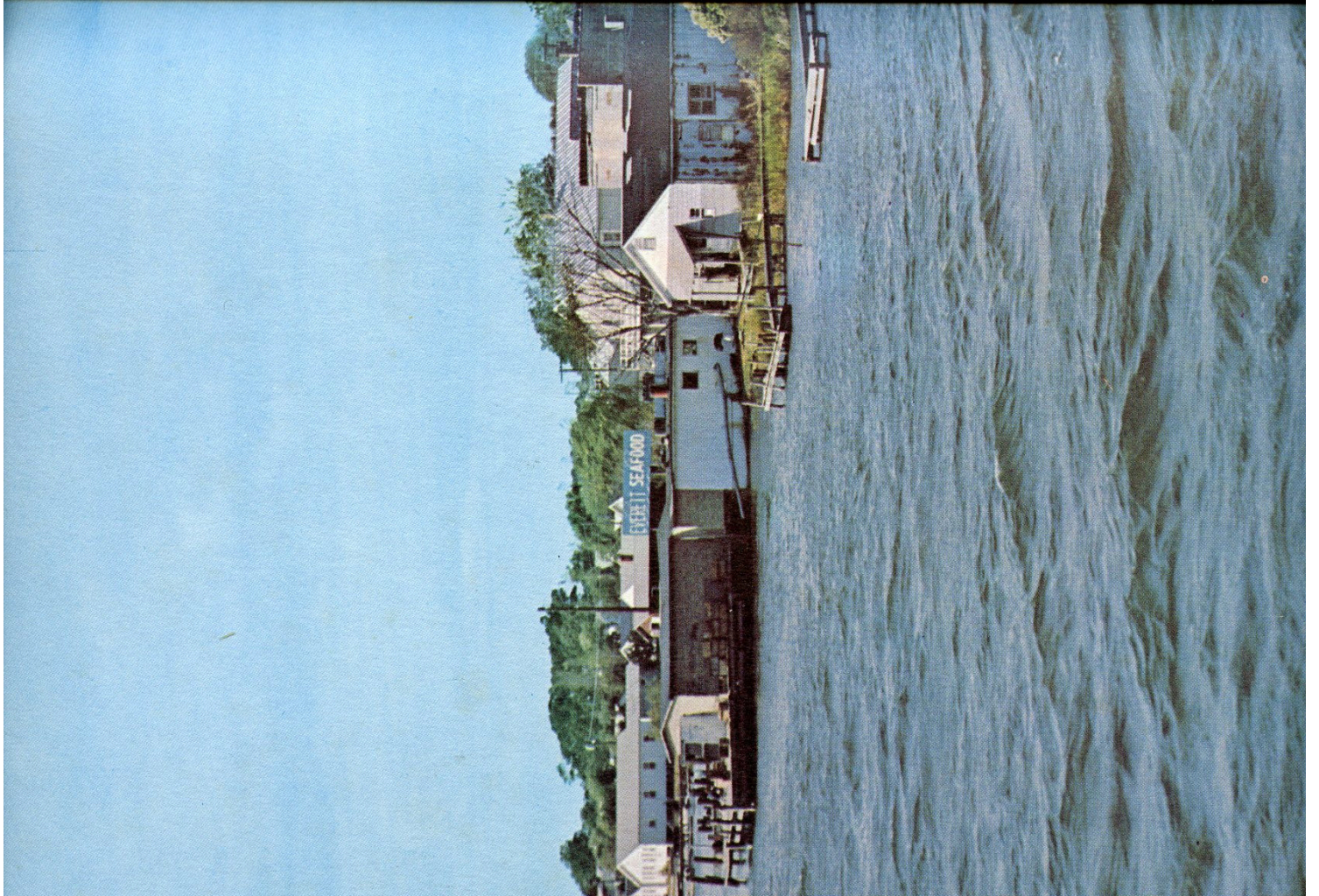
In time to come, may you thumb back through the pages and relive some fond memory. Only then will the staff have fulfilled its obligation to you.
