
In years past West's wrestling team has been producing a fine record and being virtually ignored. This past school year the enthusiasm for wrestling increased and had good reason to.

West placed 5th in the state tournament as Leo Dudley took 2nd, John Stanley 3rd, and Mike Radford 4th in their weight classes.







































### The Editor
