Mrs. Newton is a rare individual, striving not only to teach to the students, but to instill in them a true sense of identity.




EAST WIND SALUTES Coach Tom McQuaid for being an outstanding man, teacher, and coach.

Coach McQuaid was born on February 10, 1912, in Youngstown, Ohio. He attended several schools there and then moved to South Carolina to attend Newberry College where he received his AB degree in mathematics. He returned to school in Springfield, Mass. where he then received his Master's.

In 1935, he started his career teaching in Beaufort. He has taught mathematics for 41 years and all of those were in Beaufort except for 3. He moved to Cameron, NC in 1964, and taught for a year. He then moved to Sanford, NC and taught for 2 years. By then, McQuaid was ready to return home and he began teaching in Beaufort again. When Beaufort High School was closed, he moved to ECHS along with the students.


