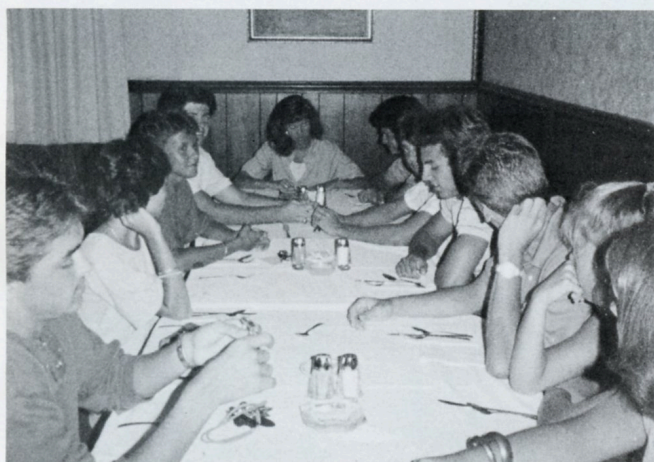
# SENIOR BREAKFAST

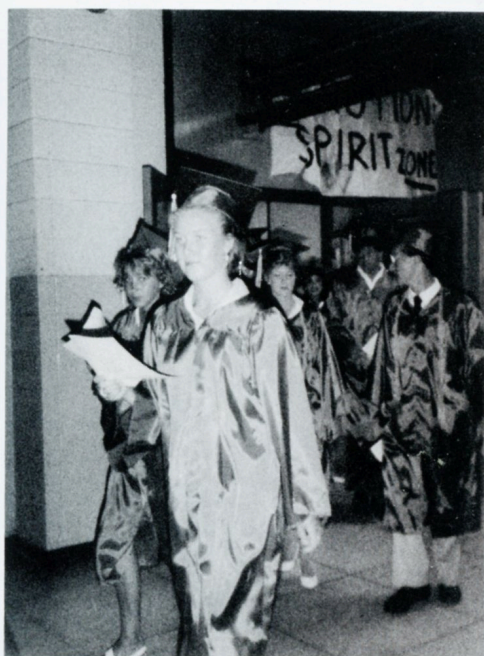
# OFF WE GO . . .
