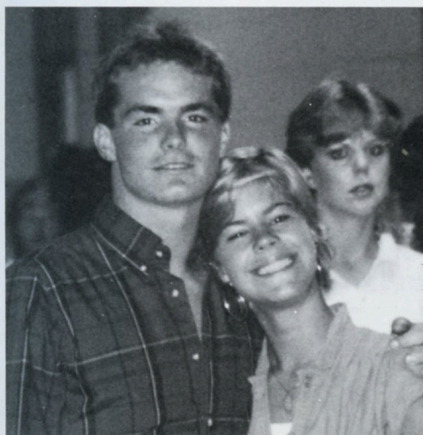
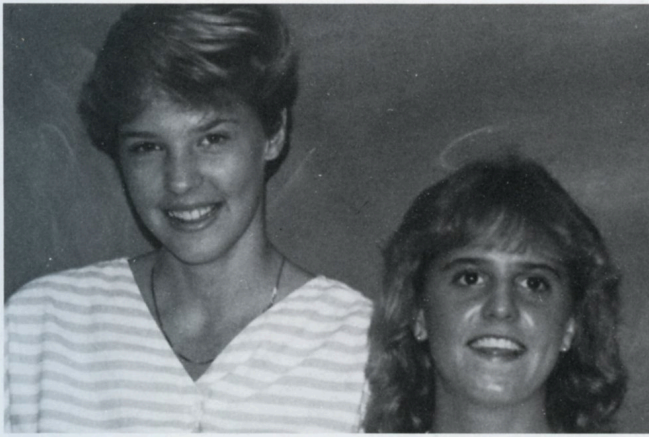
Facing ...

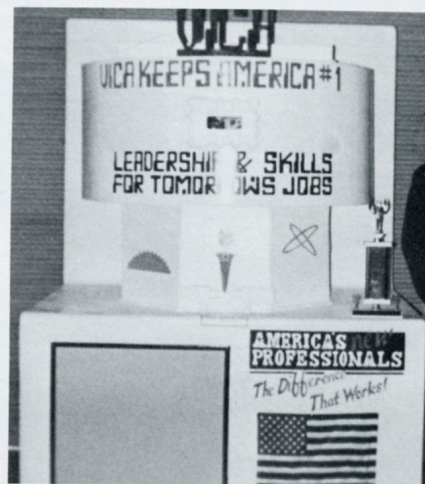
Another first was achieved when the club entered a VICA float in the Newport and Morehead City Christmas Parades.

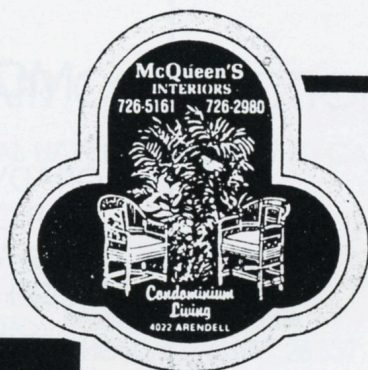
A famous poet, Gibran, once said:
