After 2 years, she transferred to UNC Wilmington and received a BA in English with a secondary certification to teach in 1994. In the fall of the same year she began teaching English at ECHS. Ever since, she

has been a respected and well-liked addition to the Mariner Family.

Mrs. Basden tries her best to live by her philosophy of a good teacher. For her a good teacher is someone who is concerned about every student and who is interested and involved in their lives. A teacher should strive to "reach" every student in his/her class by recognizing that each learns differently. He/she should be prepared to try many different methods until each student understands or learns the concept. 


Don't think of her as gone away — her journey's just begun, life holds so many facets — this earth is only one.


